Volunteer Spotlight

Carol Blair, Socializer Extraordinaire

This quarter we highlight one of our wonderful longtime volunteers, Carol Blair. Although she had unofficially started volunteering a few years earlier, she started her current job as cat socializer in August 2013. She spends at least 3 hours a week with the shelter cats, working slowly to make steps to befriend the most frightened and defensive cats at the shelter. She is able to read the expressions in their eyes to better understand what they need. She has been told she is a cat whisperer. Carol loves her time at the shelter socializing and feels like it is a very positive thing for her. She says it feels like a real job!

A native of Colorado, Carol grew up in Wheat Ridge where she attended Wheat Ridge High School (and recently went to her 50-year reunion). She earned degrees in Art Education and Psychology at the University of Northern Colorado in Greeley.

Carol was also in the Air Force, spending 8 years on active duty and 12 years as a reservist. She served at both Lowry and Edwards Air Force bases. During her years in the Reserves, she worked as an Environmental Secretary at the Tri County Health Department. She retired from her civilian job in 2008 after 31 years.

Carol has 2 cats, Clyde (15) and Misty (6). Carol originally adopted Bonnie and Clyde from the shelter, and when Bonnie sadly passed she adopted Misty. She says Clyde and Misty adore each other—they groom each other and cuddle together.

Carol, an artist, likes to paint. She does mostly landscapes but is currently working on a water-based oil painting of Santa Fe, one of the cats she enjoys working with at the shelter. She says it is slowly coming along. We certainly hope she will share it with us!

Carol recently became a Golden Circle Donor, making a wonderful and thoughtful donation to the shelter. This donation will have such a positive impact on so many cats at the shelter. We cannot thank Carol enough for this generous gift!

King Soopers Has Donated More Than \$50,000 to Cat Care Society!



It's true! Cat Care Society started the King Soopers Reloadable Gift Card Program in June 2011, CCS has received \$51,549 from King Soopers thanks to supporters who use their King Soopers Gift Cards (purchased at CCS) to buy their groceries. As of this spring, we are averaging about \$800 each month in revenue from the King Soopers Cat Care Society Reloadable Gift Card. The CCS Cats cannot thank you—and King Soopers—enough!

It's so easy to obtain and use this card...

- 1) Purchase the King Soopers Gift Card from Cat Care Society at our front desk. It costs \$25 and has \$25 of credit on the card.
- 2) Take the card to King Soopers. Either at the Customer Service Desk or at the checkstand, before you pay for your groceries, you can add any amount from \$2.50 to \$500 to your gift card.
- 3) Pay for your groceries using the CCS King Soopers Gift Card. King Soopers donates back to CCS 5% of the value of the groceries you buy each month. None of the donation comes from your pocket.
- 4) When you use up the money on the Gift Card, you just reload more. You may pay for reloading the card by cash, check, debit or credit card. (Note:

Don't let your balance stay at zero for more than 30 days; you may need to buy a new card at CCS if your card remains inactive too long.)

- 5) The CCS KS Gift Card may be used at King Soopers or City Market Fueling Centers. It can also be used at most Kroger affiliated Stores throughout the U.S. These include: Kroger, City Market, Fred Meyer, Ralphs, Fry's and Fry's Marketplace, Dillon's, Smith's Food & Drug, QFC, Food 4 Less, Owen's, Foodsco, Hilander, Pay-Less, Cala-Bell, Baker's JayC, Fred Myer's Jewelers, Littman & Barclay Jewelers.

Where Are They Now? – Tales of Our CCS Alumni Cats

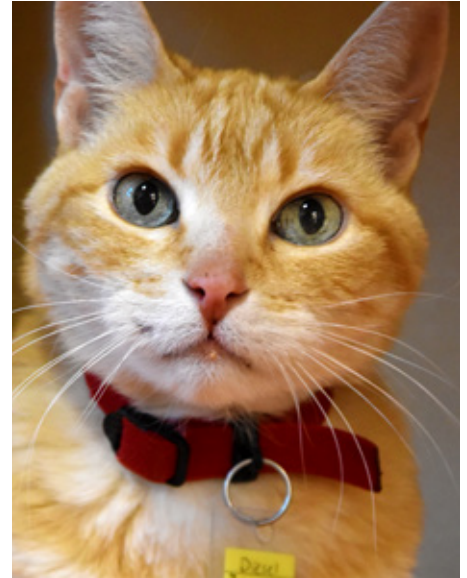
We continue to have lots of success stories to tell at Cat Care Society. We love sharing these stories with you. We've been able to give so many cats and kittens a second chance at a life of quality, in a permanent loving home, thanks to the generosity of donors like you.

Through your financial support you have helped us carry out our mission: caring for stray, neglected, and mistreated cats in the Denver metro area, and finding loving homes for as many of them as we can. We couldn't serve cats—and the people who love them—without that help.

Many of the cats for whom we've found good homes have been older, and many have had serious health issues...two factors that often lead people to consider a cat "unadoptable," or force them to surrender cats they have previously adopted. It can take a long time to place a cat in the right home, or to find the cat a second home. Meanwhile that cat remains safe and cared for in our bright, cage-free shelter, with ready access to state-of-the-art veterinary care in our Cat Clinic at Cat Care Society.

One cat that was first adopted as a kitten from CCS—then found a second loving home after being returned to us as a senior cat—represents one of our favorite happy endings from the past year.

This is the story of Diesel, and of the power of your support.



Diesel was only six months old when he came to Cat Care Society in 2004. A good Samaritan had observed him in a park, trying to get into people's homes, and took him to the Care Animal Hospital. From there he was transferred to CCS.

Diesel (the adorable orange tabby in these photos) was adopted after only eight days. Our shelter staff had identified him as needy and paired him for adoption with another cat. Diesel lived happily in his home for 13 years.

But in 2014 Diesel was diagnosed with cystitis, diarrhea, bladder stones, and urinary tract infection. These conditions resulted in improper elimination and caused him pain. Despite surgery, in three years his weight dropped from a healthy eleven-plus pounds to less than seven. His guardians could no longer afford his prescription food, medicines or additional surgery.

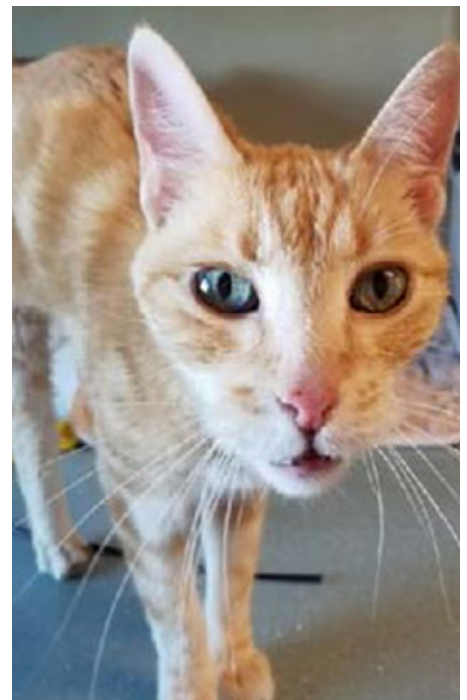
They returned him to Cat Care Society in August of 2017.

CCS always accepts returns of cats adopted from our shelter, and we were happy to receive Diesel back. Our clinic staff performed the second cystotomy surgery he desperately needed. After five months on his prescription SO diet he was eating well and gaining weight. (He was quite the chatterbox, even while eating!)

Diesel lived for a while in our copy room, so he could be closely monitored. It's a busy room and he got lots of attention. He would supervise the copying jobs and assist the volunteers with their log sheets. He had a bed in the large sunny window, where he could watch the world go by and had lots of birds to chatter at. Then he was moved to the Orange Room with two other cats on urinary-care diets. He was a master escape artist and "door runner," and kept us on our toes. He loved attention, purring at the slightest touch.

In mid-February Diesel was adopted by

a young lady with no other pets. She is committed to his mandatory Urinary SO prescription diet, which manages his urinary condition, and to his semi-annual vet visits. Since Diesel was adopted under the CCS Perpet-U-Care program, he will receive \$250.00 in veterinary services per year at the Cat Clinic at CCS.



Our young adopter was just what Diesel needed: an adoring human able to give him a safe and comfortable home, and

prepared to partner with CCS in meeting his special medical needs.

And so Diesel got a second chance at a life of quality in a loving home. But there are so many more cats out there in need of our care—so many more second-chance stories waiting to be told. With additional support, we can increase our intake of homeless, abused and neglected cats; we can enhance our foster-care program to include not just kittens, but senior and special-needs cats; we can ramp up our community outreach and bring more cats and more loving families together.

If you'll continue to help us meet our mission we can do so much more. Since we don't receive any government funding, all of our financial support must come from the community—generous donors like you who love cats. May we call on you today, for your gift of assistance to the cats?

There are several ways to give your gift. You can send a check (or authorize a credit-card charge) in the enclosed return envelope, drop off a check at the shelter, or make a donation online at catcaresociety.org. We can use either a one-time financial donation or an ongoing monthly gift—easy and convenient to set up.

Here are some of the ways your contribution will help:

- \$1,000 will take care of 30 kittens through the kitten season, including their shots, spays/neuters, microchips, food and litter.
- \$500 will cover a month of canned cat food for the shelter cats (we go through 435 cases of canned food annually!).
- \$250 will pay for 13 bags of dry cat food, to be given away at our Nibbles & Kibbles cat food and litter bank, which helps needy community members care for their cats.
- \$100 will buy 3 bags of Renal Prescription Food for our shelter cats with kidney disease.

Behavior Problems with Your Cats?

Good Kitty Behavior Consulting and Training is a business owned and operated by Billie Reynolds, an expert in cat behavior. If you have attended any seminars at Cat Care Society, you probably have met Billie; she presents many of our sessions.

Cat owners often experience difficult behaviors in their cats, and it is a leading cause of cats being returned after adoption. Good Kitty's focus is on helping clients understand their cats so that pets and humans can live in harmony. Billie's approach with individuals is to offer in-home behavior consultations, and in-home clicker training. In-home consults work to correct a behavioral issue with the cat. During a consult she gathers information about the cat and the details of the behavior problem. Billie also studies the home and areas that are important to the cat. She explains the "why's" behind the cat's behavior and provides clients with a plan. Billie might also teach clients clicker training as a method to change cat behaviors.

In-home consults and clicker training sometimes entail other resources and products as well. Email and telephone calls help with follow-up as the plan is enacted and questions arise.

If you are experiencing unwanted issues with your cat, please don't give up. Problems can usually be resolved with the right approach!
