Limited Admission Shelters in the Denver Metro Area

Limited admission shelters will not euthanize for space reasons, but will stop accepting surrendered animals when they are at capacity. They may euthanize for health, feral aggression, disease or chronic behavior issues. Each shelter has its own euthanasia policy. It is important to call first to find out if they are currently accepting cats into their facility and what their protocols are.
